Dr. Teresa La Porte is Dean of the School of Communication of the University of Navarra (Spain). She is also Professor of International Communication and most of her research is related to the analysis of international news in the media and public diplomacy. Prof. La Porte has been the Director of a research project financed by the Spanish Government on “Globalización and Pluralism in the European Public TV”, from 2002-2005 and the Director of the European Parliament Report on *Globalization of the media industry and possible threats to cultural diversity*, in 2001. She has been a Research Scholar at the London School of Economics, at the Center for International Affairs at Harvard University (as a NATO Fellow) and at the Graduate School of Political Management at George Washington University. She is the author of the book *The European policy of Franco’s regime: 1957-1963*. In International Communication, her published work includes *Mediated Terrorism in Comparative Perspective*, *The Bosnian War in Spain: The Media’s Representation of a Distant Violent Conflict*, *Le sommet á Nice. Entre la globalisation et la diversité*, *Foreign News in Spain: Reporting One’s Own Image of the World*, and *Media effect on international controversies*.
